Preparing Your Oven for the Holidays

With the long awaited Thanksgiving feast drawing near, you may want to ensure your oven is ready for the big day. Here are a few maintenance tips:

- Avoid the Self-Clean Feature! The self-clean feature causes
 the oven temperature to raise up to 1,000 degrees. This may
 cause failure of the thermostat, circuit board, or fuse. If your
 oven needs a good cleaning, use a non-abrasive cleaner to
 remove cooked-on food.
- Clean your oven properly. Use vinegar steam to clean your oven naturally. Put a bowl of white vinegar in the oven and set the temperature to 270F. After the oven is preheated, turn it off (but don't open the door). Let the vinegar sit for several hours. When you open the oven, you should be able to wipe off the food residue.
- Testing the temperature. It is important that your oven runs at just the right temperature when it comes to cooking. The oven temperature should be accurate within 25 degrees of your desired temperature. Use these simple steps to measure your oven temperature:
 - 1. Thermometer Test: For best results, purchase an oven thermometer to measure the accuracy of your oven. Start by placing the thermometer in the center of the oven and situate it in a place that you can see when the door is closed. Turn the oven to 375 degrees, and then wait for the oven to fully preheat. Once the oven is preheated, read the thermometer. Write the reading on a piece of paper. (Do not open the door!)
 - 2. Take More Than One Reading: Set your kitchen timer for 20 minutes and wait. When the timer goes off, take another reading. Repeat this step two more times so that you have four readings taken in 20 minute intervals.
 - 3. Average: Calculate the average temperature of the four readings. The result should be 350 400 degrees. If the temperature is outside of this range, contact our maintenance team at 760.281.2900 or email us at DeLuzLeasing@HuntCompanies.com.

Reasons to Change Your Air Filter

Please have all bulky items out Friday, all Have you gone through a cold winter or hot summer lately? We are pretty confident you have, especially this summer. This means that your furnace has been working in overdrive for months. Have you taken the time to change your furnace air filter? We hope so. With your furnace working hard, your furnace air filter is forced to handle more air than it normally does. This will lead to your filter wearing out in record time.

The first reason you must replace your furnace air filter is because regular maintenance will decrease how much dust is in the air. Many people will never notice that there is more dirt and dust in the air. However, people with allergies, asthma, or other respiratory diseases will notice it in a heartbeat. By installing a new furnace air filter, you

will be making it easier to breath for everyone in your home and also reducing the possibility of exposing them to a major health risk.

The second reason you must always replace your furnace air filter is because dirty filters are excellent breeding grounds for bacteria and fungus. If your filter isn't changed on a regular basis mold and bacteria can get into areas of your furnace that are perfect breeding grounds. When this happens, not only does mold and bacteria multiply and grow, but microscopic pieces will get pushed through the furnace and out into your home. This can be very dangerous, especially since you will have no idea where the mold and bacteria are coming from.

We encourage residents to change their air filter MONTHLY if you are utilizing the air circulation feature or heating function on a regular basis. This will ensure that your HVAC system is not working harder than it should and allow the HVAC system to continue to work throughout the fall and winter season with minimal issues.

As a reminder, DeLuz Family Housing provides air filters at no cost to our residents. Just stop on by the Community Management Office between 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday, to pick one up today.

Bark Park Etiquette

DeLuz Family Housing wants pet owners to enjoy some quality time with your pet(s) at the fenced-in Bark Park. As a reminder:

- Hours of operation are Monday Sunday, from dawn to dusk
- Families live in the immediate area, so keep noise to a reasonable level
- Your pet must be leashed at all times walking to and from the dog park
- Pick up after your pet and dispose of the waste

Let's Get Ready for that Colder Weather

Even if you're not ready for the colder weather, you can easily make your home ready. Below are some helpful tips to help protect your home.

- Check the furnace to make sure it is operational!
- Change your air filter monthly to keep your furnace working properly throughout the winter season. You can get a FREE air filter by visiting the Community Management Office during normal business hours.
- Set your thermostat to auto and heat to at least 65 degrees during the winter season.
- Notify the Community Management Office if you're going on vacation for extended length of time.
- Make sure all windows and doors are closed if running your heater.
- Assess entry ways and windows for drafts. Weather stripping can be installed!
- Do not warm up your vehicle inside your garage, this can create high levels of carbon monoxide in your garage and your home.
- Make sure heat registers are not obstructed.
