MAINTENANCE TIPS

Regular maintenance helps keep your home safe, efficient, and comfortable. Here are this month's quick reminders:

- Inspect and Clean HVAC Systems: Change air filters every 1–3 months, clean vents and ducts, and schedule an annual inspection to keep your system running smoothly.
- Check for Water Leaks: Look for drips, puddles, or water stains around sinks, faucets, toilets, and pipes. Report any leaks to us immediately to prevent damage.
- **Test Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Detectors:** Test detectors monthly, replace batteries at least once a year, and reach out if you notice any issues.
